Scholarship Categories

I. <u>The Mary C. Scales Academic Excellence Scholarship</u> – Awarded in honor of the late Mrs. Mary C. Scales, a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Pi Nu Omega Chapter. Mrs. Scales was an educator, civic leader and community icon. She was the first African American faculty member at Middle Tennessee State University and the first African American female member of the Murfreesboro City Council. The Murfreesboro City School - Scales Elementary is named after Mrs. Scales and her late husband. This scholarship recipient is the highest Academic Achievement Scholar.

Criteria:

- Cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or better
- o ACT score of 26 or better
- Demonstration of leadership excellence
- Awards & Recognitions
- 300 to 500-word essay (double-spaced in MLA format) on topic A or B below
 - A. Colin Kaepernick took a knee to bring attention to the abuse by police officers toward African Americas, and the racial oppression of African Americans in the United States. In doing so, it can be argued that he sacrificed his NFL career for what he believed. Is there a cause that you are willing to make such a sacrifice for? Why? How would you motivate others to support your cause?

The primary focuses will be breast cancer awareness and prevention, heart health, nutrition and wellness, and care for the caregivers. The scholarship recipient aspires to earn a STEM degree.

- o Plan to major in a Science-Technology-Engineering-Math (STEM) related area
- Demonstration of leadership excellence
- 300 to 500-word essay (double-spaced in MLA format) on topic A or B below
 - A. The current opioid epidemic is the deadliest drug crisis in American history. In your opinion, how can medical professionals, government officials, law enforcement, and citizens join forces to end this heinous attack on Americans? Please be specific and detailed.
 - B. Describe a personal experience where a chronic illness or disease has impacted you and your family. What strategies did you and your family use to accommodate for the illness or disease? Describe the outcome of your response.

- IV. <u>Global Impact</u> Alpha Kappa Alpha engages in programming designed to enhance the international foot print of the sorority. Focus is on community service projects that have an international impact, as well as partnerships with organizations that make a difference worldwide.
